Application to revoke land as a private timber reserve

Requirements

Under section 14 the *Forest Practices Act 1985* the owner of private timber reserve may make an application to revoke all or part of lands declared as a private timber reserve.

This application for the revocation of a private timber reserve must contain a description of the private timber reserve, or part of the private timber reserve that the applicant wishes to cease to be, or cease to be to form part, of a private timber reserve.

The applicant must also specify the reasons why the application is being made.

A separate revocation application is required for each different ownership, even though the land may be managed as one unit. For example, A. Smith, AB Smith, AB & CD Smith, A Smith & Co, or A Smith & Company Pty Ltd are all different titles and require separate applications to revoke the Private Timber Reserve.

A FULL copy of the current title, in the name of the applicant, for each area of land covered by this application to revoke the private timber reserve must accompany this application. A FULL copy includes Folio text, folio plan and where available Property Report.

Please provide a 1:25,000 map with the area to be revoked clearly identified. Shapefiles should be provided with any part title applications if available (email to diana.hall@pft.tas.gov.au)

The area to be revoked as a private timber reserve can cover part or all of a number of titles.

There is no application fee to revoke a private timber reserve.
