Under section 5 (4) of the Tasmanian *Forest Practices Act 1985* we are/I am required to notify all persons who have a legal or equitable interest in the land, or the timber on the land, of my application to have the land listed below declared a private timber reserve

As a person who has a legal or equitable interest in the land, or the timber on the land, you may object to my application.

Under section 8 (2) of the Tasmanian *Forest Practices Act 1985* any objection must be made on one or more of the following grounds;

- the application has not been made in good faith and honestly,
- the land is not suitable for declaration as a private timber reserve,
- a person who has a legal or equitable interest in the land, or timber on the land, would be disadvantaged of the application was granted,
- by the virtue of the operation of any Act, the owner of the land is prohibited from establishing forest, or growing or harvesting timber , on the land,
- it would not be in the public interest to grant the application.

Any objection must be lodged with the Private Forests Tasmania and a copy sent to me/us within the objection period specified in the Public Notice.
